#### January 21 – Casting Call Mark 1:14–20

#### January 28 – Called to Truthful Love Mark 1:21–28

Whose voice do you give authority? Pay close attention to that person this week and see if you can figure out why.

#### February 4 – Called to Healing Mark 1:29–39

So many people with so many needs. Pray each day this week for those who heal bodies, minds, spirits, and relationships.

#### February 11 – Called to Resurrection Mark 9:2–9
