

Helping Our Neighbors... It's Time to Celebrate!

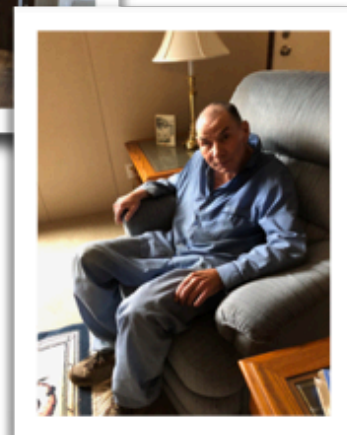
**April 29 from 3-5 p.m.
